We are in very uncertain times at present. It is so important we follow community restriction rules so we don't have an outbreak in our area.

A huge thank you to parents for following the restrictions of not coming onto school grounds. This was not an easy decision to make as we love having our community in our school.

The advice from the State Government and Health authorities is:

***'visitors to school grounds should be limited to those delivering or supporting essential school services and operations'***

We are hoping that we are able to reduce the risk by practicing social distancing, good hygiene practices and not gathering in large groups.

## Covid update

We hear many things in the media in regards to schools at present such as conducting temperature checks and remote learning. At this stage these procedures are only required for Metropolitan schools.

South Street will continue to operate as we were in Term 2 to upon returning from remote learning. Students will be washing hands regularly and the school cleaning has increased with a cleaner on site during school hours. The only change that we have made is that parents/carers are no longer permitted on site.
