These meetings are a great chance for students to keep in touch with their teacher and classmates. They also help keep in flow with a normal school routine.

Meetings will continue to run as per the below timetable:

Grade 5 & 6:

9:00am Teams meeting on Monday's, Tuesday's, Wednesday's. Students at school Thursday and Friday (Funday).

Grade 3 & 4:

9:30am Teams Meeting on Monday's & Thursday's. Students at school on Tuesday's & Wednesday's. Friday: Students at home completely Friday Funday activities.

Foundation, Grade I & 2:

No more Teams meetings as they are allowed to be at school daily. There will be no learning resources provided if your child does not return to school.



Our current Department guidelines only allow us to have essential visitors on the school grounds.

For now this means that parents are asked to refrain from coming onsite unless previously organised.

Junior Swimming

Although we have come out of lockdown this week there are still restrictions on how indoor recreation facilities can operate.

- -Indoor physical recreation facilities including gyms, play centres, indoor skate parks and trampoline centres can open with up to 10 people per facility indoors.
- Indoor swimming pools can open with up to 20 people per facility, subject to a density limit of 1 person per 4 square metres. Outdoor swimming pools can open with up to 50 people. Changing rooms remain closed.
