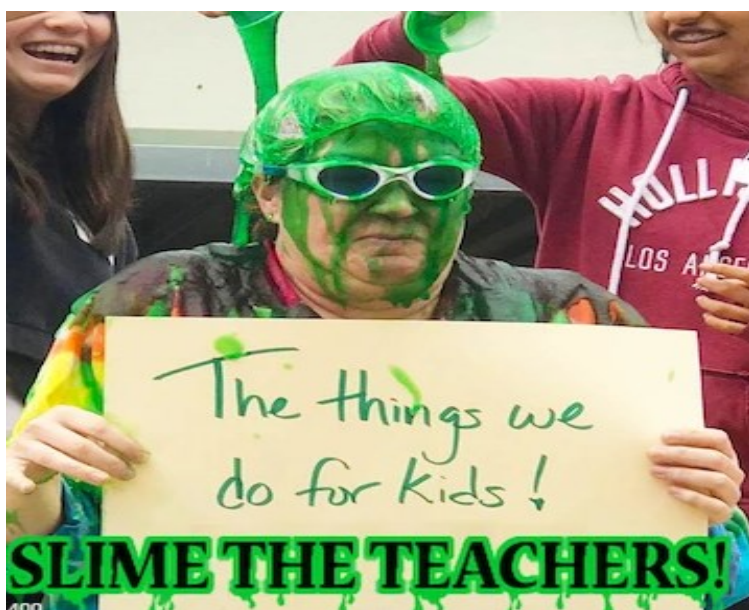
Students can pick up sponsorship booklets for the Slime Run Fund-raiser on 26th November.

We will serve the same spread of breakfast items for students between 8am – 8.25am every morning.

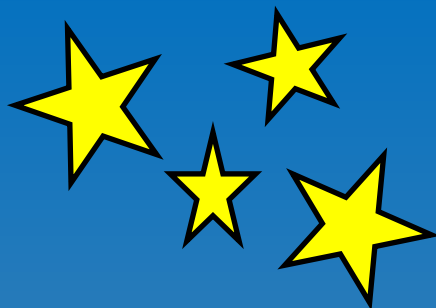
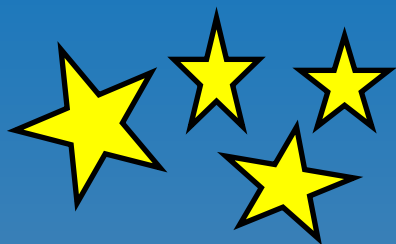
