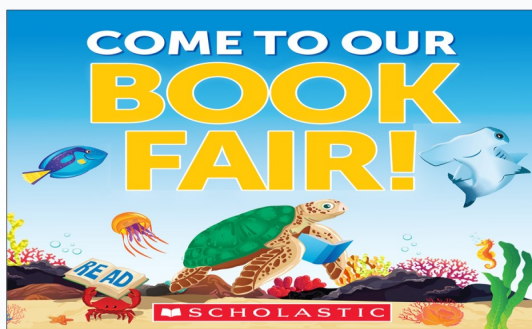
Principal's News....
