Principal's News....



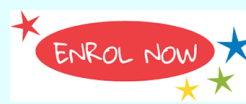

close on Wednesday 22nd June at 4:00pm.**

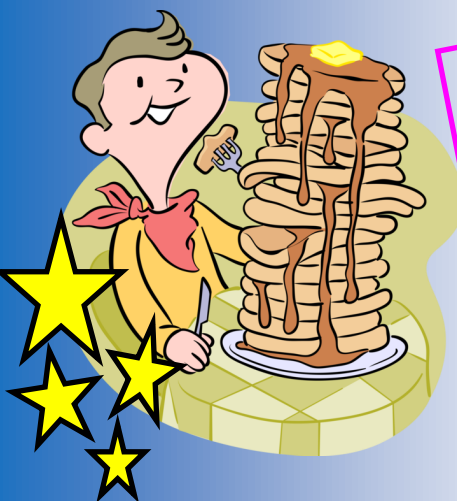
If you don't have a Sentral account, please see Mrs Murphy as soon as possible to organise one so that you are able to book your interview with your child's class teacher.

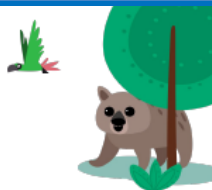
