Every 4 years the school goes through an external review

conducted by the Department of Education. Recently we reflected on the past 4 years of South St and the success we have had during that time. This report will be made public after the review process.



#### Our successes and highlights



Our Naplan growth data for reading from year 3 to 5. Our above benchmark growth was 46% of children compared to 29% for similar schools, 26% for the region and 27% for the state. Over 4 years of the strategic Plan our average above benchmark growth was 32%.



Our Attitudes to School survey (student survey Years 4 - 6). Students have connection with an adult at the school is at 90% positive, High expectations for success at 93% and sense of inclusion at 90%. The review stated that these were excellent compared to other schools she has been involved with.



Also the review mentioned an average of 75% of our children through the student survey said they have not experienced bullying (in the question it states in the last month). This is good compared to other schools. The other pleasing factor was that our children say if they experience bullying it is dealt with by the staff.

Our staffing set up with ES in every classroom, extra behaviour support and the wellbeing staff support .

#### Thursday 23rd June 3:30pm-5:00pm & Friday 24th June 9:00am -12:00pm


