

FREE Sound Scouts hearing tests at South St Primary!

What? Sound Scouts is a fun App where kids play a game (while having their hearing checked) on an iPad/tablet using a set of headphones while we supervise. A report will be automatically generated following the test which I can send to parents/carers via email if required

When? Hearing tests will begin from next week and continue over the next month or so at school

> Who? We will be conducting hearing tests for Grade 2 and Grade 4 kids only

Why? Any hearing test results where a concern is identified, may indicate a referral to Gippsland Audiology for further testing. We will contact parents/carers if a referral is required. Hearing tests



are encouraged due to the importance of early intervention of hearing issues. Optimal educational outcomes are dependent on good hearing!


