SCHOOL REVIEW REPORT

This Tuesday we had the pleasure of hosting our school reviewer, Zenda Clarke from Monash University, who presented the review report findings to our staff and school council.

A school review occurs every four years and is an opportunity to celebrate the school's successes and achievements and identify areas of growth that will help the school improve. These improvement areas will become the focus of the school's next strategic plan.

A strategic plan is our statement to you and the school community about what we stand for and intend to do over the next four years to improve student outcomes.

Over the subsequent few editions of Snippets, leading up to the end of the term and into Term 4, I plan to share the report with you and communicate the goals, strategies and targets that will be part of our next strategic plan.

I will start by sharing the first highlight identified by the independent panel.

STUDENT WELLBEING

Specifically, during the past four years:

- ◆ We placed a significant focus on the wellbeing of students, which was recognised by the panel as contributing to a positive school environment.
- ◆ Extensive wellbeing structures that supported students and their families were initiated and embedded.
- ◆ Classroom observations and interviews with students during the review process provided evidence of a respectful relationship between staff members and students.
- ◆ Students who were interviewed in small focus groups overwhelmingly said they felt safe both in the classroom and in the playing areas of the school.
- ◆ Parents who participated in a parent focus group agreed their children enjoyed coming to school and were connected to the school, their teachers and the Education Support (ES) staff.
