News from the Principal

Our School Swimming Carnival turned out to be a great success on Monday; although a few senior students noted it would have been nice to have the water temperature turned up a tad! This event was also the first time we could utilise Compass Events to give permission and consent for students to attend activities and excursions.

I want to thank our parent community for embracing Compass, and I trust that many of you will be enjoying the quickness, efficiency and ease of communication Compass provides, particularly for school events such as our swimming carnival. We need to have all families signed up and registered to Compass. Whilst we could ring and contact families for our swimming sports program who hadn't given consent, this will not always be the case in the future. By registering to Compass and interacting with the platform, you will be able to give consent for our upcoming events and not miss out on vital information from the school.

Compass also provides you with the ability to let us know if your child will be absent from school. If your child is away for the whole day, please add an attendance note in Compass. If they will be late for the morning or picked up early, students should sign in or out of the office. As a reminder, all students who are late or need to leave early must go through the office. You can still pass this vital information on to your child's classroom teacher by using Compass Connect – the messenger and chat service available through Compass.

We are also aware there have been issues with Android users. Our office team have logged this with Compass directly, who are working on any bug fixes. If you need assistance and support with Compass, please come to our help sessions starting this Monday afternoon.

Looking ahead, this Tuesday, we welcome the team from Hot Fx to our school for our annual photo day. The photo program will commence at 8:40 am. All students need to be at school on time every day – but it is particularly important for photo day. Thanks to the families who have dropped off their photo forms at the office. Having this information ahead of the event makes it easier for the team to coordinate and collate orders for the company and get in touch with families who may have missed this information.

I am also pleased to invite you to our Welcome Afternoon – Games on the Lawn in a few weeks. Held on Wednesday, the 1st of March, from 4:00 – 6:00 pm, there will be a free BBQ and drinks, games and sports activities for families, and all staff will be in attendance.

It has been great to meet and welcome families back to school for the 2023 school year, and this informal event provides another opportunity for you to come along and meet our team.

This week our students in ProActive play have been focusing on 3 key areas of positive play:

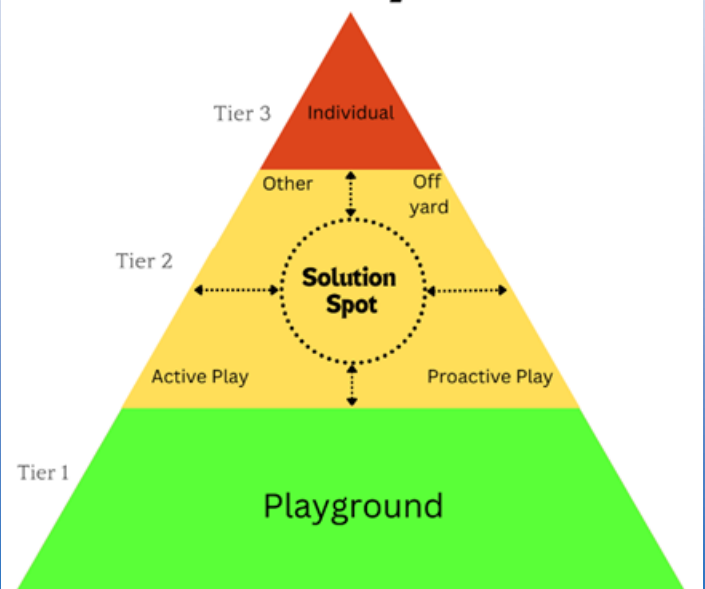
- Following instructions and the rules of different games

Order envelopes must be returned to the school by Thursday the 16th of February.

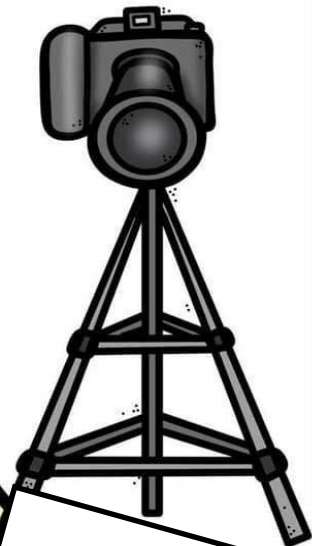

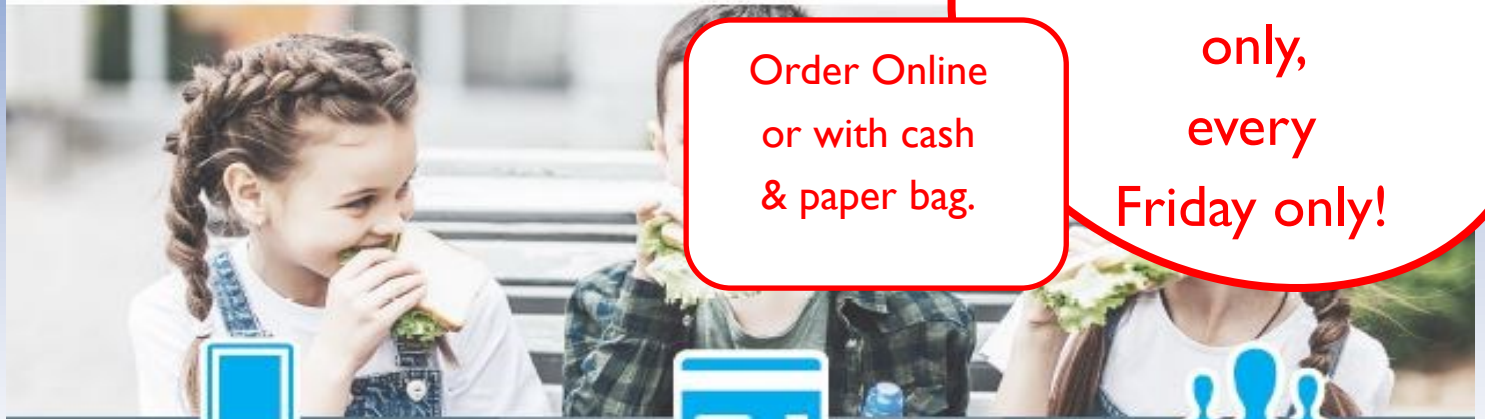
