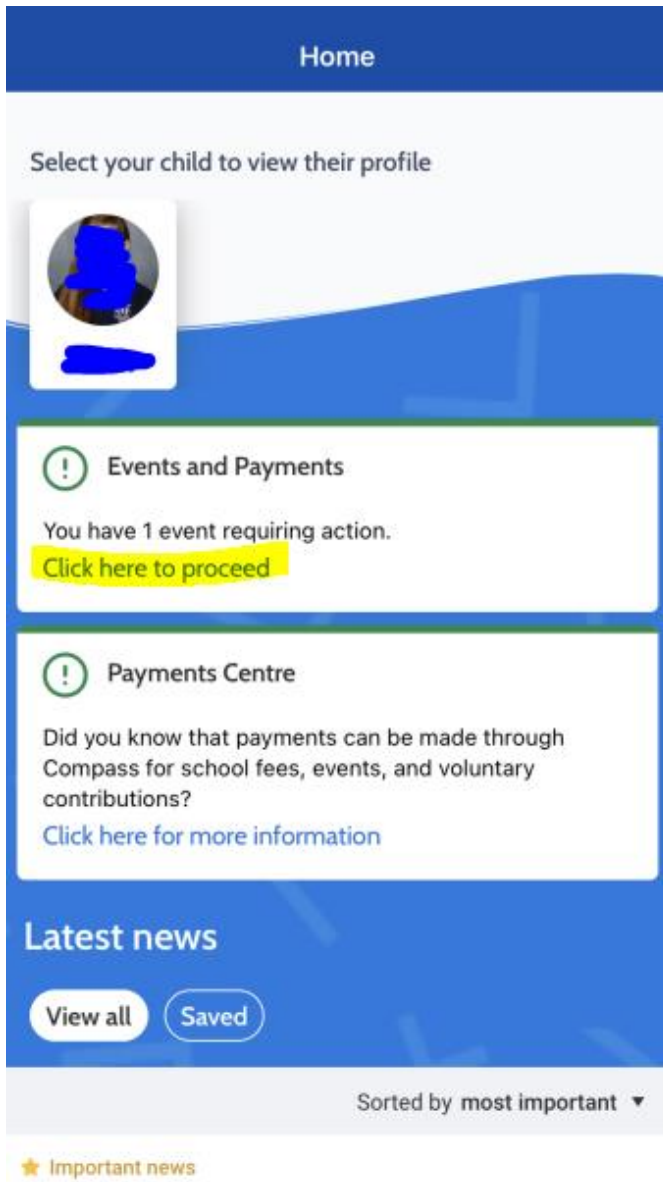


Compass Consent Instructions for App Users.

If you would like your child to attend, you will need to read all the details and fill out the consent form on Compass. This is a step-by-step process and will take a few minutes, it can be done in the Compass app.

- 1) Click on the “Click here to proceed” link under your child’s name. This will take you too the Events and Consent hub.





- 2) Click on the arrow to go onto the next page. If your child has been selected for the competitive try outs in the morning you will have two events and need to complete the consent process for both.

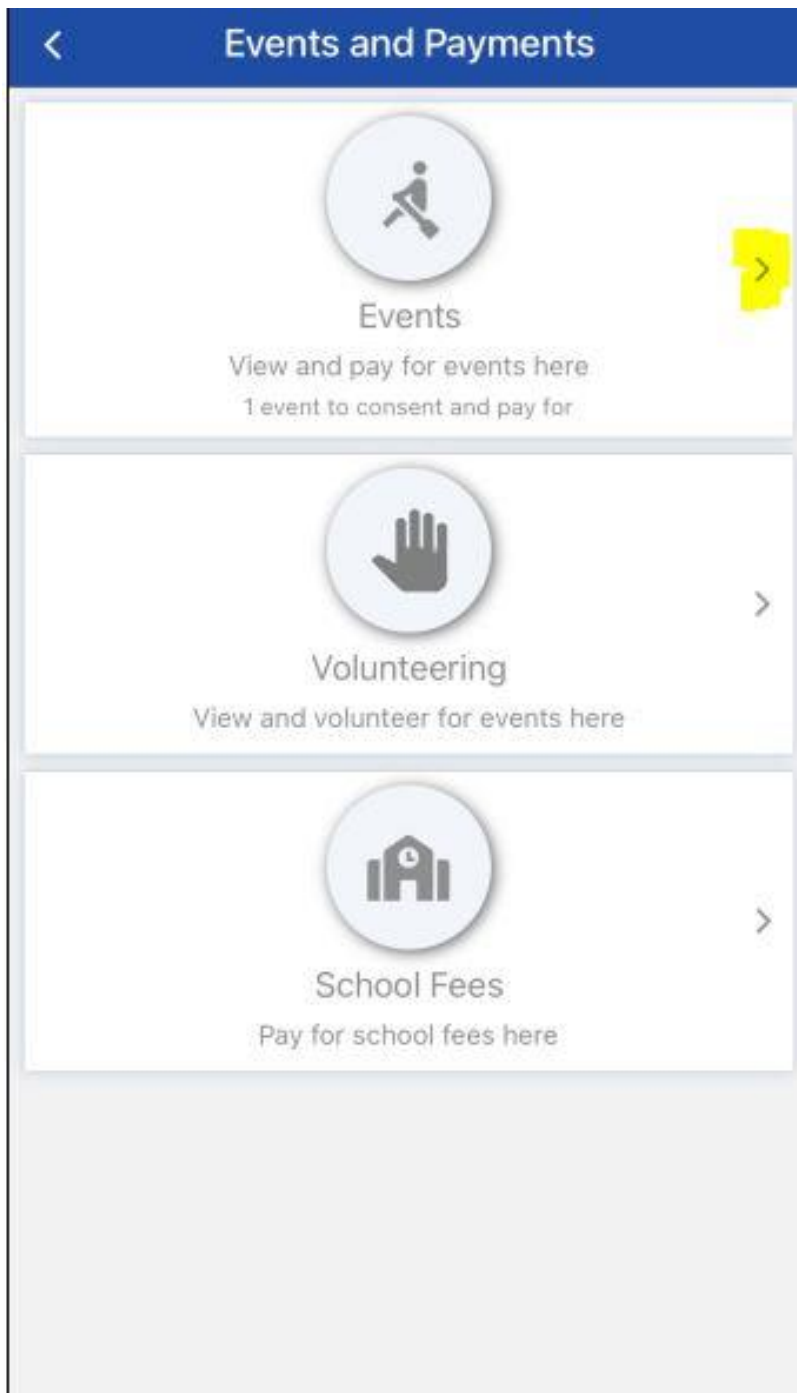
