COMPASS Canteen

I would also like to provide an update on the COMPASS Canteen feature. Last week was our first time using COMPASS as our canteen ordering system.

Our volunteers led by Mrs Wiggins and the office team, worked incredibly hard to set this up, and we were amazed at the level of support from our families. We are pleased to be able to utilise COMPASS for a range of features and are thankful for your support as we slowly use the full range of features available to us.

As always, if you are having trouble or need assistance connecting to an internet-enabled device, please come into the office, as we have iPads set up and ready to be used by families.

COMPASS Attendance

Continuing with the theme of seeking your support, I would like to continue to talk about and share the importance of attendance – being at school on time every day.



Parents and carers can also support us to record student attendance by:

- Utilising COMPASS to submit attendance notes when their child/children are absent from school
- Ensuring students sign in at the office when they are late for school

When adding an attendance note in COMPASS, please add a clear description in the Details / Comments section. This provides us with a clear understanding of why your child is away and can be used by us to change the note to the correct code or provide support if needed.

Our goal is to ensure that all absences are explained and there are no unexplained absences. You can help us by making sure that any absence by your child is explained by adding an attendance note in COMPASS and including a comment.

Did you know that you can submit an attendance note ahead of time for planned absences, and you can go back and submit an attendance note for dates in the past? Doing so will significantly support us in ensuring that our attendance data is up-to-date and accurate and another way that we can work together to get the best outcomes for your child.





School Nurse News










St John Ambulance Australia is committed to promoting the importance of first aid in the community and believes that there is no better place to start than in our schools.

"How to put people in the recovery position and to call 000 in an emergency"- Marley 56B









COMPASS Attendance Tutorial

Entering an Attendance Note

- From the Compass home screen (or from your student's profile), click the **Add Attendance Note** item.
- From the pop-up window
 - Select the reason
 - Enter a brief description of the absence
 - Select the start and finish time
 - Click the 'Save' button

Where possible, attendance notes should be entered prior to the absence/lateness occurring.




