Over the last few years we have had a cat living under the North Wing of our school. We have been unable to catch him/her. The Office staff often left food out but the crafty cat still alluded us. More recently "**Cat**" had become a little bit more curious and was coming out more frequently. Due to this we noticed "Cat" had a sore on his/her head. Chantal, one of our Parents, is a helper at **The Nine Lives Project**. Chantal and her team managed to catch "**Cat**". Here is an up-date on "**Cat**".

"Hey all, forwarding updated photos of Tiger known as your local South Street 'Cat". He is a beautiful boy currently having some treatment for his head wound . He was microchipped and after contacting the last listed owner, he has been surrendered today. Tigers been missing for so long (approximately 6 years) and their circumstances had changed. Tiger's birth date is actually 11/4/2014 so he is 9yo which is 52years old in cat years! Tiger has been fully vet worked, and he is loving the chance to live his 9th life. We thank you for allowing the rescue to bring him in. To our amazement he was a much loved boy who travelled all the way from the top of Moe even wondered past those busy roads and highways where he found shelter and a safe place at your school.

He will have another booster shot and another full check- up. Tiger will then be going up for adoption.

This is a fantastic result so far. He will be available to find his forever home once he's all healed.

We will keep you updated and hopefully can find someone that would love to let him live his ninth life.


