News from our Acting Principal



As the term comes to an end, please ensure that you inform us of any absences that your child may have during the last week of school.

Principal's Message, school
attendance each
and every day is so important to
overall academic success and
personal growth.

The first stage of our approach to attendance (the same as all schools across Inner Gippsland) is ensuring that we promote attendance, its benefits and accurately record attendance data.

We accurately record student attendance at South Street Primary School by:

- Marking the roll twice daily at 8:40am and 12:20pm
- Ensuring contact is made with families after consecutive days absent from school
- Ensuring students arriving late (after 8:40am) or leaving early (before 3:00pm), sign in or out using our Compass Kiosk
- Wellbeing Officer reviews all attendance notes submitted by parents / carers.

Parents and carers can also support us to accurately record student attendance by:

- Utilising Compass to submit attendance notes when their child/children are absent from school
- Ensuring students sign in at the office when they are late from school.











As we finalise and publish reports, please make sure to get in contact with us if you have any problems or issues accessing your children's reports via **COMPASS**.

Classroom teachers and our lovely office staff will be able to assist with most of your **COMPASS** inquiries.


