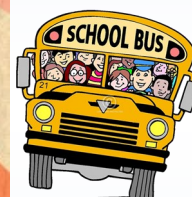
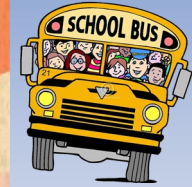
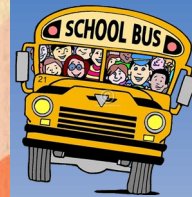

Zoe Bantock on reaching the Victorian State Cross Country Championships!!!!

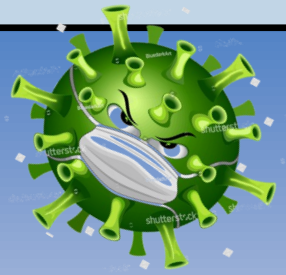

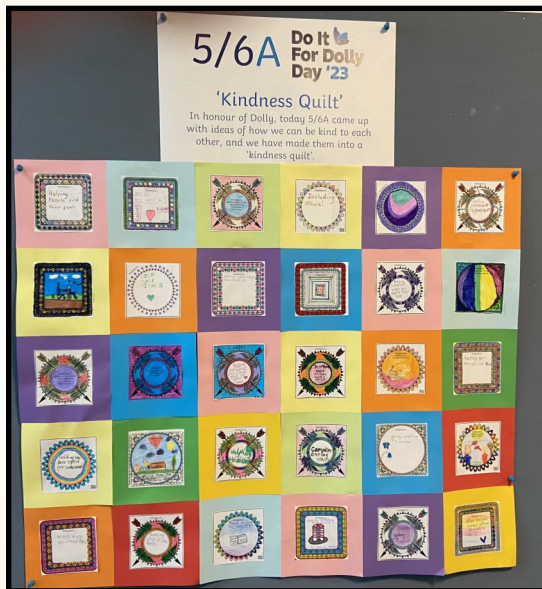


P1B—Hygiene Session

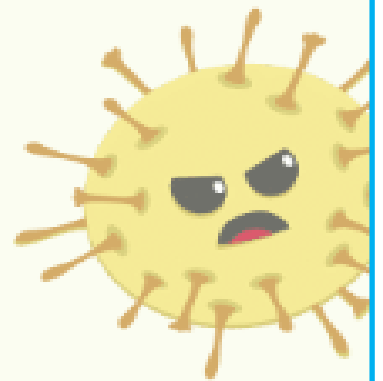
