


# School News

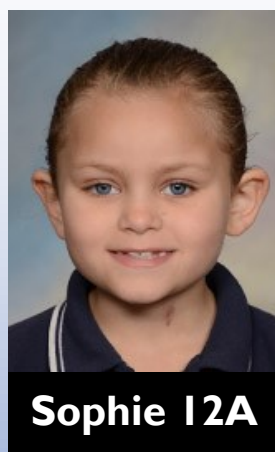
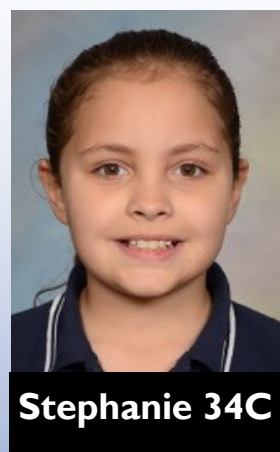
