## MORNING ROUTINES & GETTING TO SCHOOL ON TIME

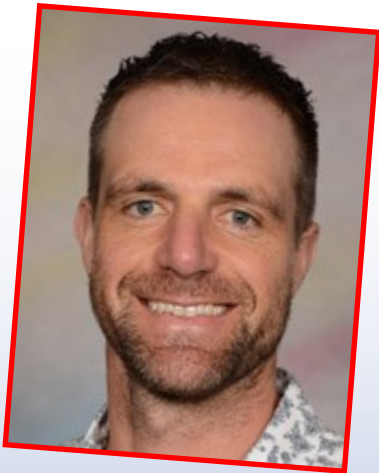
