The addition of Before School Care is a fantastic opportunity for all families at South Street and will support many of our families in the morning.

Before School Care Continued

Key Information:

1. **Early Drop Off Option:** Before School Care will operate from 6:30am to accommodate the early morning schedules of all families. Students will be cared for in a safe and engaging environment until school begins at 8:30am.
2. **Healthy Breakfast Provided:** A wholesome breakfast will be provided to all students regardless of their arrival time, ensuring they have the energy and focus needed for the school day.
3. **Games and Activities:** Before School Care isn't just about getting ready for the day; it's also about having fun! There'll be a variety of games and activities to keep your child entertained and socially engaged, including a quiet corner for relaxing.
4. **Supervised Environment:** Our Before and After School Care provider, In2Learning Gippsland have trained and caring staff members who provide high-quality care and assist your child, ensuring a safe and positive atmosphere.
5. **Casual Use Permitted:** You do not need to use the service on a full-time or regular basis. Perhaps you might need care for a day or a few days a month or in an emergency situation. You can enrol your child to use the service when you need it.
6. **Subsidised Cost:** For eligible families with a health care card, the child care subsidy provides up to 85% of the cost of child care, equating to approximately only \$4 a session!

How to Enrol:

Our Before and After Care service will be operated by In2Learning Gippsland, this is the same provider that currently runs after-school care.

We are encouraging any families that might consider using either service to enrol with In2Learning Gippsland. We are working through the final details of how this looks, and as soon as we have it, we will publish it via Compass and Facebook.

We encourage you to reach out with any questions or to learn more about our Before and After School Care program. Our office team can assist with any enquiries.

The introduction of this service for 2024 is another exciting addition for the families of South Street Primary School.

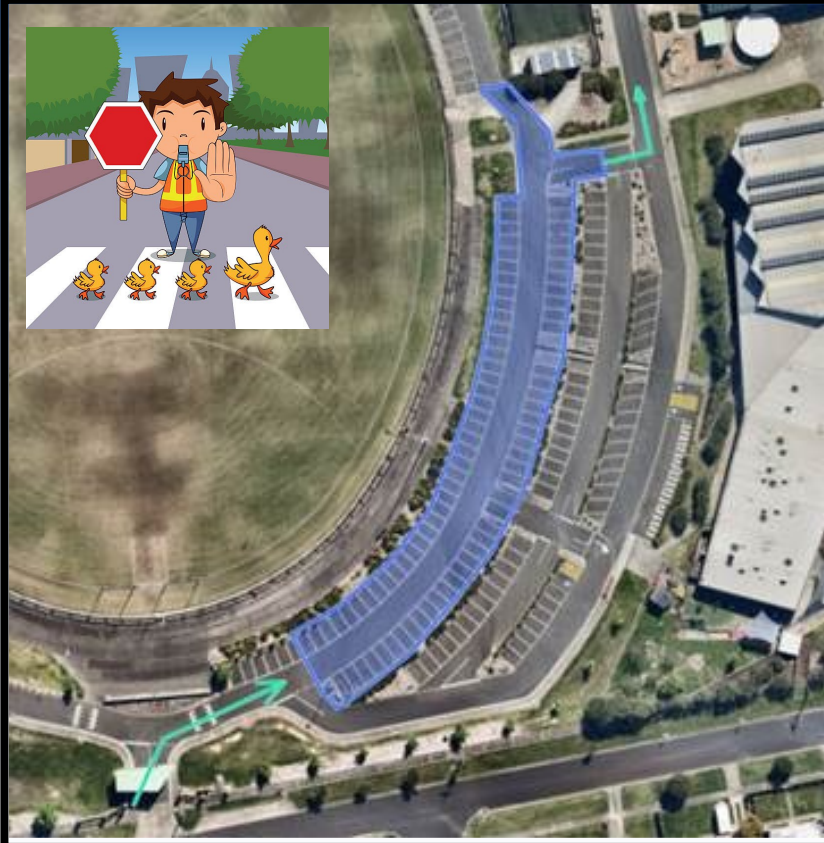

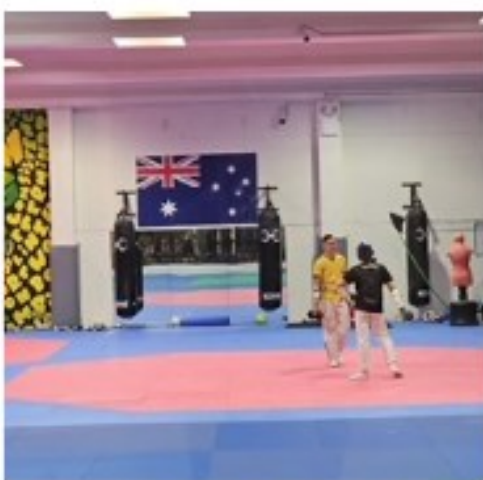


GRADE 3/4 CAMP
