Whilst our uniform is already blue – it is time to take this to the next level on Tuesday the 14th of November as we celebrate World Diabetes Day!

This coming Tuesday, we are encouraging our entire school community to become involved by wearing blue – headbands, hair accessories, and clothing – anything blue will do!

It is in support of children living with type 1 diabetes, including two of our very own students, Tyler Goyne and Darcy Platschinda.

As part of the day, we are also looking to raise funds for the JDRF – the leading supporter of type 1 diabetes in the world. JDRF have established a program which provides insulin pumps for young children/young adults. Since this program has been established, they have provided 2100 pumps to young children/young adults.

“Our son Darcy was lucky enough to have been provided a pump through this program. The pump has been life-changing for Darcy and us as a family.”

In support of Darcy, Tyler and the many other students across the world living with type 1 diabetes, everyone at South Street is encouraged to wear blue and bring a gold coin donation. The gold coin will also give you a chance at the jelly bean guessing competition.

The funds raised will support the research into diabetes and help families with the supply of insulin pumps, just like Darcy.

With a cause so close to home for our school community, I hope we can come together in blue and raise some money for a foundation to find a cure for diabetes.

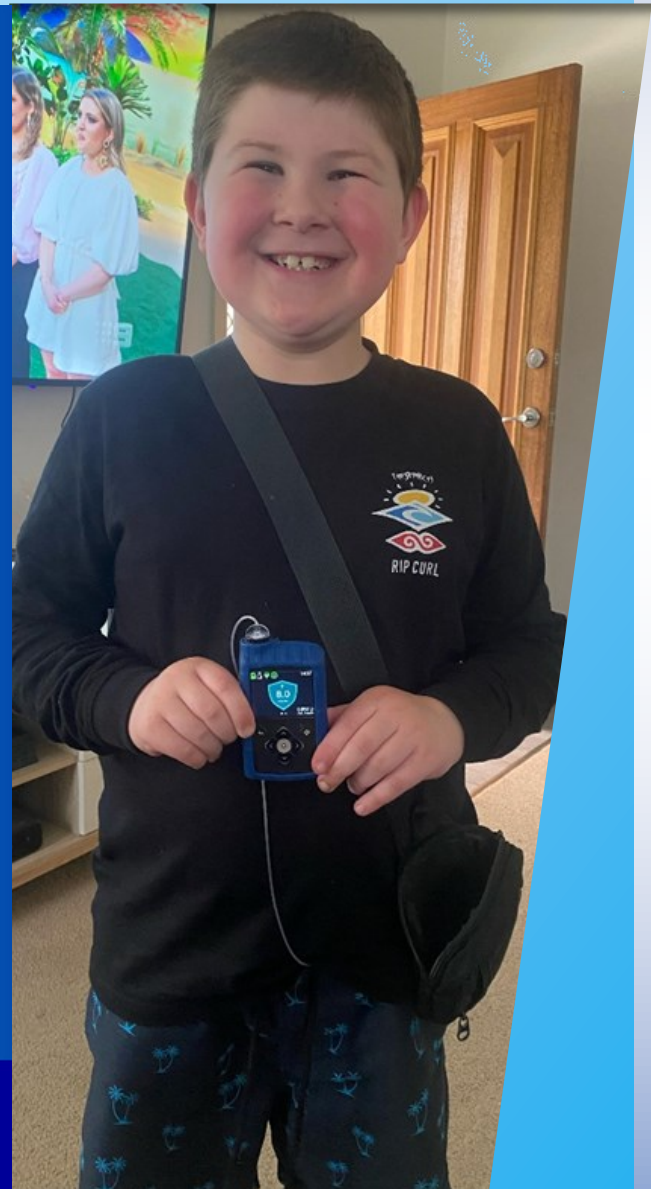

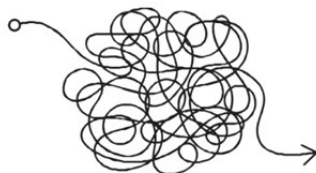

- A sports car



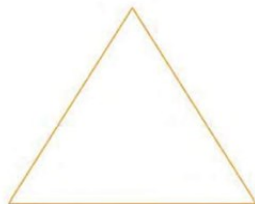
Left Right Brain

It's that time of the week again, here are a couple more Positive Primers to try out on the family at home.

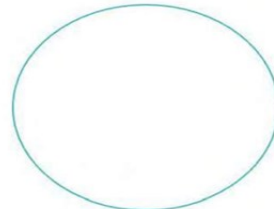
Don't forget that Positive Primers are like scuffing the surface of the student's brain so that the learning sticks.

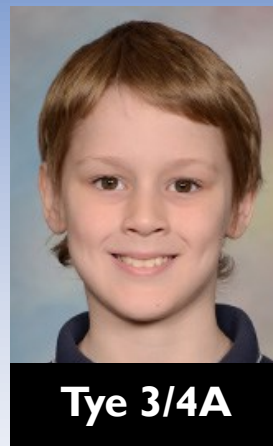
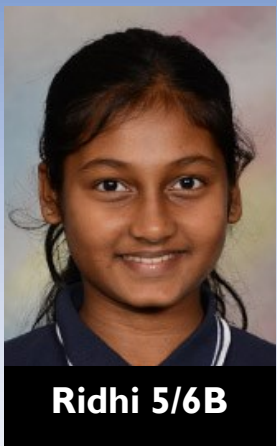
